**Fall Group Art Show**

BWAC continues its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration with the Fall Group Art Show, opening Saturday, September 17<sup>th</sup>. The exhibit is free to the public and open weekends noon to 6PM.

As diverse and colorful as autumn leaves, BWAC's Fall Group Art Show features over 600 works by over 300 artists. This practically guarantees that the viewer will encounter pieces ranging from the provocative, such as Tom Vinton's *Repose*, to Gary Heller's contemplative *Autumn...Perkins Point, NY*, to the serene (Jessica Schulman's *Dune Tree*). The exhibit is presented in an historic Civil War-era waterfront warehouse in Red Hook, Brooklyn with its million dollar view of the Statue of Liberty.

Opening day activities include a Meet the Artists Reception with performances by vocalist/percussionist/lyricist and composer Paula Jeanine and American Ghazal.

Using traditional South Asian musical forms of ghazal, thumri and raga, Ms. Jeanine writes and performs material with a modern sound from an ancient source. Ms. Jeanine has recently returned from a teaching and singing tour in India. She will be performing several new pieces, and will be accompanied by Lee Boice (guitar, bass, sitar). Performances will be at 2PM and 4PM.

**Location and Directions:** The Fall Group Art Show is located at 499 Van Brunt, Brooklyn.

Both the B77 (G and F Train to Smith/9th) and the B61 (A and F Train to Jay Street) buses go to Van Brunt Street (last stop).

Approximately 20 minutes by car from downtown Manhattan: Brooklyn Bridge becomes Adams Street, make a right onto Atlantic Avenue, left onto Columbia Street, right onto Degraw, left onto Van Brunt and continue on Van Brunt to end. From Brooklyn: Northwest on Hamilton Ave., make a left onto Van Brunt. Continue on Van Brunt to end.
